R Boaz

A mighty man of wealth (2:1)
Elimelech's near kinsman (4:3)
Meets Ruth and provides for her (Chapter 2)
Naomi advises Ruth to be around Boaz
Boaz desires to redeem Ruth (3:9-12)
Nearer kinsman consulted; unwilling (4:3-6)
Boaz redeems Ruth in marriage (Chapter 4)
